“The Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them out ahead of him in pairs.” It’s one of the Lord’s great ideas to send his disciples out in pairs rather than alone. Working alongside others gives us friendship and support, inspiration and encouragement. In fact it’s such a good thing that Jesus even wanted it for Himself.

He chose to be born into a loving holy family. From the beginning of His public ministry He gathered a group of close friends around Himself. Within those twelve there was the even closer group of Peter, James and John who accompanied Jesus at some of the most significant moments in His life: the raising of Jairus’ daughter, the Transfiguration, and the agony in the garden of Gethsemane. He also cherished close and supportive friendships with others like Mary Magdalene and Martha and Mary of Bethany. On the Cross He was consoled by the presence of Mary His mother, Mary Magdalene and His beloved disciple John. After His Resurrection, it was to His friends that He appeared and commissioned them to spread the Good News throughout the world.

As the Lord sends us out as labourers into His rich harvest to continue that work, we too can’t do it alone. We need friends for encouragement and support, for sharing ideas and talents. But most of all, when we work together for the Gospel, Christ is with us in a special way: “Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them.”
