


- Evangelii Nuntiandi (1975)
 - a fresh forward impulse, capable of creating within a Church still more firmly rooted in the undying power and strength of Pentecost a new period of evangelization.
 - Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses.




Look to the future with commitment to a New Evangelization, one that is new in its ardour, new in its methods, and new in its expression.


Address to Latin American Bishops (1983)



- 1. Christ and his Gospel are not known→ Mission ad gentes
- 2. Christian communities fervent in faith
 → Church activity and pastoral care.
- 3. Countries with ancient Christian roots lost a living sense of the faith live a life far removed from Christ
 - → New Evangelization or Re-evangelization



I sense that the moment has come to commit all of the Church's energies to a new evangelization and to the mission ad gentes. No believer in Christ, no institution of the Church can avoid this supreme duty: to proclaim Christ to all peoples.



Our own time, then, must be increasingly marked by new hearing of God's word and a new evangelization

... vigorously to embark upon the new evangelization, especially in those nations where the Gospel has been forgotten or meets with indifference as a result of widespread secularism.



In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples. All the baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization.

... The new evangelization calls for personal involvement on the part of each of the baptized.

What is New about the New Evangelization?

- Nothing!
 - Same message
 - Same mission
- Everything
 - The Gospel is always new
 - Here is a teaching that is new, with authority behind it: he gives orders even to unclean spirits and they obey him. (Mk 1:27)

What is New about the New Evangelization?

- There has been a crisis of Evangelization
 - for various reasons …

All people will be saved ???

- Vatican II
- *Lumen Gentium* **15 16**
 - Non-Catholic Christians
 - Jews
 - Muslims
 - those who do not believe in God
 - can be saved …
- → Evangelization is unnecessary?

All people will be saved???

Logical error (1)

"Can be saved" = "Will be saved"

All people will be saved???

- Lumen Gentium 16 the last paragraph
- But often men, deceived by the Evil One, have become vain in their reasonings and have exchanged the truth of God for a lie, serving the creature rather than the Creator. Or some there are who, living and dying in this world without God, are exposed to final despair. Wherefore to promote the glory of God and procure the salvation of all of these, and mindful of the command of the Lord, "Preach the Gospel to every creature", the Church fosters the missions with care and attention.

Logical error (2)

"Can be saved"

"Don't need to know about Jesus"

A Crisis of Evangelization

- Presuming all people will be saved
 - → Evangelization is unnecessary
- Mistaken understanding of Dialogue
 - →Evangelization is just my monologue
- Culture of Dissent
 - >Evangelization is me imposing my personal ideas
- Mistaken view of Liturgy and Sacraments
 - → Evangelization is cultural imperialism

A New Cultural Situation

Modern Science

- Philosophical turn to the subject
 - "I think therefore I am"
 - subjectivism
 - secularism

Crisis of faith

A New Pastoral Situation

- Post-Christian Culture
- In the world
 - presumed atheism
 - presumed disposal of Christianity
- In the Church
 - lapsation
 - sacramentalised but not catechized
 - sacramentalised but not evangelized

Solutions?


- Be aware of the issues

 - To this end, it is more necessary than ever for all the faithful to move from a faith of habit, sustained perhaps by social context alone, to a faith which is conscious and personally lived. The renewal of faith will always be the best way to lead others to the Truth that is Christ.

Solutions?

- Culture of thinking with Christ not dissent
- Awareness of distinctiveness of faith
- Centrality of Person of Christ
- Evangelization flows from the Trinity
