Last Saturday, 10 October, Carlo Acutis, an Italian teenager (born in London) was beatified. He was born in 1991 and died of leukaemia in 2006 at the age of 15.

He is best known for creating a website (<http://www.miracolieucaistici.org/en/Liste/list.html>) describing Eucharistic miracles from around the world throughout the history of the Church, including a number from recent years. We know that in the Eucharist the bread and wine really become the body and blood of Jesus, although we cannot see or taste the change. This is what is called transubstantiation. In Eucharistic miracles however, the outward appearances also change into flesh and blood, as a special gift from God to strengthen our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus.

Creating this website combined Blessed Carlo's loves for the Eucharist and for computing. He attended Mass daily from the time of his First Holy Communion (and also had a deep devotion to Our Lady and went to Confession weekly). But he also had a great love of and ability in computing, learning computer programming from a young age. He has been informally called the patron saint of the internet.

Finally, his cheerfulness and his care for his friends and those in need should be mentioned, protecting victims of bullying, helping the homeless and volunteering in a Milan soup kitchen.

Keeping Safe at Church

Test and Trace. When you arrive at church the stewards will request your names and phone / mobile numbers. Alternatively, if you have downloaded the NHS Covid-19 App on your phone, you can simply scan the **QR code** near the door in each church.

Please note that you are not legally required to give this information, and if you choose not to, you will not be excluded from entering the church. However, we encourage you to cooperate in order to provide the best protection we can for all in our society. The attendance books will be kept securely, and we will not use this information for anything except Test and Trace.

Church Capacity. As we are now getting over 50% of our pre-Covid attendance at Sunday Mass our churches are reaching their full capacity with social distancing in place. So, if you are able to come to Mass on weekdays maybe you could think about sometimes not coming on Sunday, to make room for others who don't have the choice. (But please, don't all stop coming at once!) Don't forget that the Sunday obligation is still officially suspended, and you can always join in via the live-stream.

We hope to use St Alphege Hall for overflow seating for the 9.00 am Mass as soon as all the necessary protection measures are in place. This will provide Mass streamed onto the screens and Holy Communion brought to you in the hall. Watch this space ... !

Socialising after Mass outside church. Please do remember appropriate social distancing after Mass. It's lovely to see everyone ... but please do keep the dangers to yourselves and others in mind.

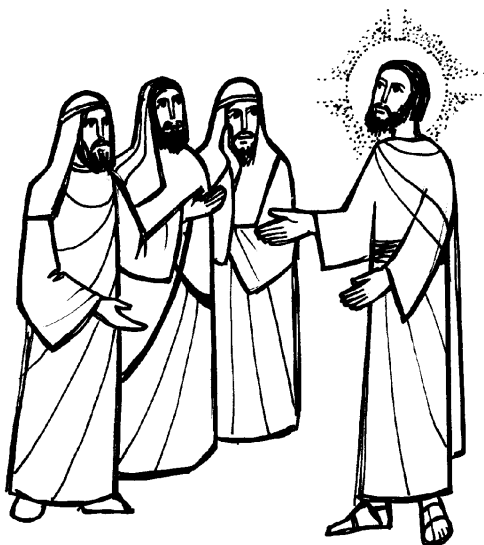
