The strangest thing happens in today's Gospel. James and John ask for something outrageous—places at Jesus' right hand and left hand in His kingdom—and Jesus *doesn't* tell them off! Instead, He tells the other ten disciples off for getting so indignant at the brothers' audacious request.

The point is, I think, that Jesus has seen the good—as well as the obvious bad—in James' and John's request. The ten see only the hubris, and they are probably a little jealous of their own positions of closeness to Jesus. Will the brothers oust them from the positions of honour that they are secretly hoping for? But Jesus sees more. He sees James' and John's desire to be close to

Him, in other words, their love for Him. He sees their desire to be active figures in God's kingdom. He sees their ambition to achieve real greatness—even if they are going about it in completely the wrong way. So Jesus purifies their aspirations rather than crushing them. He encourages them to make great sacrifices for Him: sharing His "cup" and "baptism" of suffering. And He wonderfully transforms their ambitions for worldly glory into desire for true, heavenly glory.

And He does the same with each of us, if we let Him, if we have enough love for Him to ask for places near Him in His kingdom, enough ambition to hope for God's kingdom to come. He can see and build on the good in our hearts, even if He's the only one who can see it.
