As the liturgical year draws to a close, every year we dedicate the coming month of November to those who have died. On Tuesday we celebrate the feast of All Saints—a Holy Day of Obligation—honouring all the canonised Saints we know about and, perhaps even more importantly, the millions of others, unknown to us, who have

dedicated themselves to Christ in this world and now reign with Him for ever in heaven.
