## 32<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Special Collection this week: Retired Priests' Fund (Gift Aid)

The widow in today's Gospel is an amazing woman. She puts into the poor box all the money she has—every last penny! She has some important lessons for us. That's why Jesus pointed her out to His disciples.

Firstly, she shows us that each of us can offer something wonderful to God. It doesn't matter whether we are rich or poor; whether we are clever or not; whether we have much time or not. Everyone can make a valuable contribution, a worthwhile offering to God. So what we are called to give? Everything we have. Whatever we have—time, money, talents, a helping hand, a listening ear, a good example—large or small we must give them all to God. We must use them for God's glory and to help our neighbour.

But the widow teaches us something else, something even more important. Our translation of the Gospel says she put in "all she had to live on". A more literal translation would say she put in "her whole life".

And when Jesus saw her doing this, it was just a few days before He gave His whole life on the Cross. The widow's offering of everything she had makes her like Christ; or, rather, by His gift of interior grace, Jesus has made her like Himself. And *therefore* her gift—so paltry to earthly eyes—becomes amazingly valuable. For the effectiveness of our giving is not determined by its monetary value, but by how deeply we are participating in the self-giving of Christ.
