

Why is Peter going back to fishing? It seems especially odd following last Sunday's Gospel when Jesus appeared to the Apostles in the Upper Room and commissioned them: "As the Father sent me, so am I sending you." But then, people do odd things, especially Peter—like putting his clothes on before jumping into the sea! And Peter's relationship with Jesus has been seriously wounded by sin. Three times Peter denied Jesus. Three times that wound must be healed.

So three times Jesus asks, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" Now that's an interesting sort of a question. Jesus knows the answer to it, and Peter says as much: "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." So what does Jesus mean by it? It's not a challenge, "Well, do you love me or not?"; it's not an ultimatum, or anger, or Jesus getting His own back for Peter's denials.

Instead, of course, it's Jesus reaching out to Peter in pure love. Jesus is enabling Peter to express his sorrow and his love. Peter needs Jesus to give him this opportunity; he couldn't have done it on his own initiative. Basically, Peter needs to go to Confession, and Jesus makes it possible. Jesus still values Peter's love, despite everything. He still wants Peter: He wants him to be His friend, He wants to share everything with him. And that includes a real share in Jesus' work of saving us. "Do you love me?" "Lord, you know that I love you." "Feed my sheep."

And, as always, what applies to Peter applies in one way or another to us all!
