Sundays: Cycle B Weekdays: Year I 20 December 2020



At last we have a Gospel that's beginning to feel really Christmassy! Over the previous weeks of Advent we have thought about Jesus' second coming at the end of time, and we have heard St John the Baptist announcing the beginning of Jesus' public ministry: "Prepare a way for the Lord!" But today we hear the Angel Gabriel announcing to Mary that she is to be the mother of Jesus. He will be the Son of David, the "Messiah" or "Christ", our awaited Saviour; and—even more wonderfully—He is the Son of God.

The "atmosphere" of the Gospel has also changed. The previous scenes have been in public, but this one is domestic. Up to now we have heard a solemn call to staying awake and conversion of heart (and we all need a bit of that! Have you made your Advent confession yet?). But now there is a sense of excitement at the Good News—especially from Gabriel—and not a little confusion

and alarm on the part of Mary, finally transforming to her wonderful and total "Yes" to God.

In this strangest of years—whatever sadnesses, anxieties and confusions we have experienced—let's make sure our homes and our hearts are more than ever full of joyful expectation as we await once more the birth of our Lord Jesus into our world and our lives.

We will be having five Christmas Masses to celebrate our Saviour's birth this year, to allow as many people to attend as possible given the limitations of social distancing.

We are operating a booking system to prevent, as far as possible, people having to be turned away because the church is full to its limited capacity.

Christmas Eve

6.00 pm OLOS (the church is full, there are still six seats suitable for 3 couples or 3 individuals in the Hall);

9.00 pm HS (one family row and three seats);

Christmas Day

Midnight OLOS (still some seats)

9.00 am OLOS (still seats);

10.30 am HS (seats for four largish families or several couples and individuals)

To book a place, please contact the parish office—by email if possible, otherwise by phone. You need to state:

- (a) How many people are in your group.
- (b) Which Mass times you would consider attending, ***in order of preference***.

If you are signed up to the Parish Gift Aid Scheme, please use a purple envelope. Please add your Gift Aid number or your Surname and postcode or else we can't get the tax back!

If you are not in our Parish Gift Aid Scheme but would like to Gift Aid, please use a yellow or white envelope.

Donations sent into the Presbytery should be labelled "Christmas" but remember cheques should be to "Parish of Effingham and Fetcham". Thank you.

Advent Confessions. Please note the following times and places for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the run up to Christmas:

Sat 19 Dec: No morning confessions, sorry, but an early start in the evening: 4.30–5.30 pm, OLOS.

Sun 20 Dec: Following the 11.00 am Mass at HS.

Mon 21 Dec: During Adoration, 11.00–11.45 am at HS.

Confessions at Holy Spirit will be in the servers' sacristy behind the sanctuary. Please use the right-hand door at the back of the sanctuary.

Mass and Confessions – next Saturday 26 Dec. No 10.00am Mass, and no confessions, but the evening Mass at 6.00 pm will be celebrated as usual (first Mass of the Holy Family).

First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation

Now is the time to apply for preparation for First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation. Children aged seven or over on 1 September 2020 (school year 3 or above) are welcome to apply.
