The Baptism of the Lord

Well, the turkey and the mince pies have been eaten, the gifts have been given and received, the tree and tinsel and lights have come down, and we've stopped singing carols. I guess that's Christmas over for another year. Liturgically, of course, that's one day early—Christmastide ends today—but even so ...

Is that all there is to it? A celebration come, a celebration gone, just 349 shopping days left till Christmas 2022? Or has Advent and Christmastide

made a difference? What did you want to gain from the season this year? How did you want to be different? And, more to the point, what did Jesus want to bless you with? How did Jesus actually come into your life and into your world? What do you now want to give thanks for, looking back over the last six weeks?

It's worth spending some time pondering the events of the season and what blessings we have received, just as Mary stored up the events of Jesus' birth and childhood, and pondered them in her heart. Recognising—and perhaps even being surprised at—where Jesus has been active in our lives gives us courage and direction for the weeks and months ahead. Today and over the next few weeks we hear about Jesus beginning His public ministry, proclaiming the closeness of God's kingdom to all who will listen.
