### **Christ the King**

Sundays: Cycle A   Weekdays: Year II   22 November 2020



Today we conclude the Church Year with the celebration of Christ, our Shepherd King. He came as our Good Shepherd and entrusted us to one another. When he will come to evaluate our life and how much it is worth in his eyes and in ours, he will ask: Have you cared for one another, have you served, especially the poor and weak? This is not only a matter of serving people: it is also serving God, for the neighbour in need is no other than Christ himself. It is therefore an act of deep faith. In Mother Teresa's memorable words: 'The worst disease in the world today is the feeling of being unwanted, the greatest evil is lack of love. What the poor need even more than food, clothes, and shelter, is to be wanted.' Hence, the words of Christ are as relevant today as ever. Here are some examples of response to Appeals for help for people in need in what is a very challenging and difficult year. Jean will be writing to the

Parish thanking them for the overwhelming response last Saturday to the appeal for clothing and goods to send to the refugees in the Greek Islands. Churches Together in our villages are preparing 500 Christmas Boxes to be given to those whose lives may be difficult. We have the annual shoebox appeal for Romania as another example. Children in Need raised a record £37m and Captain Tom raised £33m for the NHS. Let us pray that we may be found worthy to be counted as true followers of Christ.

You can drop it through the presbytery letterbox, or put it in the collection box at the back of the churches when they are open for private prayer. If you wish, you can also include a donation, which will go towards the Holy Souls Masses celebrated throughout the year.

Now is the time to apply for preparation for First Holy Communion and First Reconciliation. Children aged seven or over on 1 September 2020 (school year 3 or above) are welcome to apply.
