### **Arrivals and Departures**

Effingham and Fetcham parish will be welcoming **Fr Charles Howell** as our new parish priest. He will be celebrating his first weekend Masses on 27-28 Jan (while he is still in the process of moving in) and will begin weekday Masses on Fri 2 Feb.


Fr Stephen is leaving our parish on Thu 11 Jan. His new appointment is initially to Storrington, but with the remit of combining that parish with Arundel Cathedral parish, working together with the present dean of the Cathedral. In the late spring or early summer Fr Stephen will then take over as the new dean of Cathedral.

Between Fr Stephen's departure and Fr Charles' arrival, **Fr Benny O'Shea** will be celebrating the weekend Masses (6pm, 9am and 11am) and will be available for Sat evening Confessions at 5pm.

**Second collection today**: Emergency appeal for the victims of the conflict in Israel and Gaza, organised by the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem. Please be generous! Thank you.

Change to Children's Liturgy. There will be NO Liturgy this Sunday 7 Jan. It will resume as usual on  $21^{st}$  Jan.

**Change to Confessions.** This Sunday 7 Jan there will also be no Confessions at HS after the Mass, as Mass will be followed immediately by Fr Stephen's Farewell celebration.
